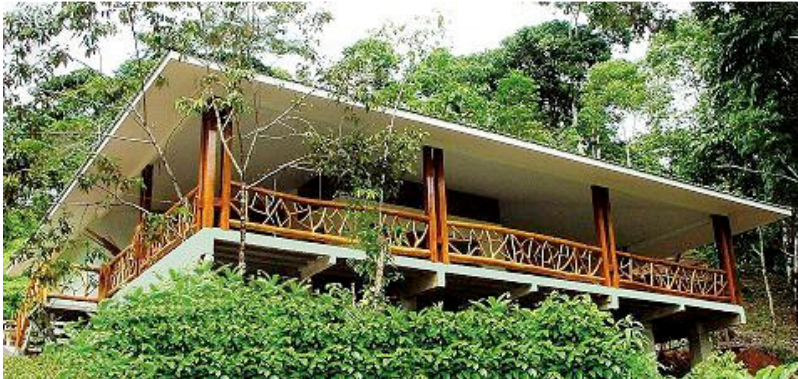


## What's new in the project

A chance for all members of this group to gather with realtors and tour operators located in San José.

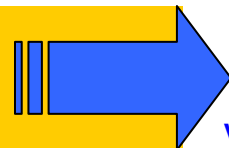
